Dear Reverend Pflug,

Thank you for the generous gift sent to Samaritan's Purse from Windermere Presbyterian Church for U.S. Disaster Relief. We are truly grateful for your prayers and partnership as we help people whose lives have been turned upside down.

Hurricane Helene was the worst storm that anyone in this region can remember—the devastation is unbelievable and will require years of recovery. Our disaster relief teams are working to help hurting people in Western North Carolina, Eastern Tennessee, Georgia, and Florida. Staff and volunteers continue to clean mud and waterlogged material out of homes, cut up fallen trees, tarp damaged roofs, and much more. Over 33,000 volunteers have come alongside us to help so far, and many more will be needed in the coming months. We flew over 350 helicopter missions to deliver critical supplies to storm victims in isolated areas and then trucked in more than 200 loads of necessities to communities as roads became more passable. We also opened an additional site in Florida to help hundreds more families whose homes were damaged by Hurricane Milton, and we have teams working in Oklahoma City to help families impacted by tornadoes.

Please pray with us for those who are hurting. As we bring relief in Jesus' Name, we want to share God's love and the hope of the Gospel. *"For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved"* (John 3:17). May God bless you.
